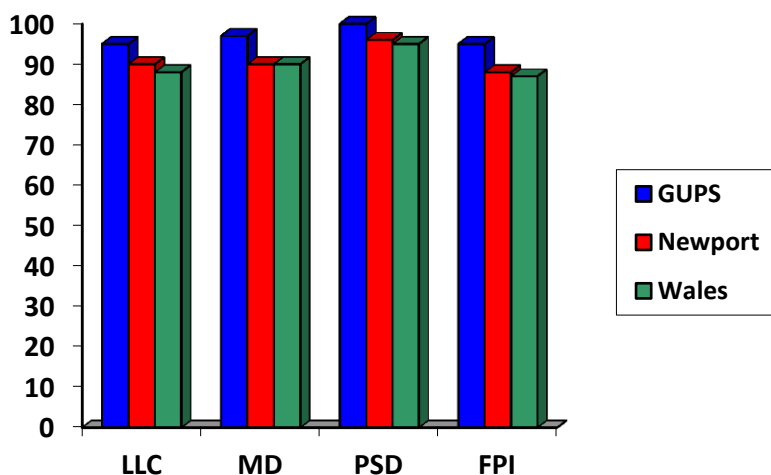
## School Data Information – National Curriculum Assessments 2014-2015

### Foundation Phase

Pupils in Year 2 are assessed according to Foundation Phase outcomes at the end of the year in Language, Literacy & Communication (LLC), Mathematical Development (MD) and Personal Social Wellbeing & Cultural Diversity (PSD). The Foundation Phase Indicator (FPI) shows the number of pupils who achieved an Outcome 5+ in all 3 areas of learning. Pupils' class work and tests are used in the assessment.

### Results at Outcome 5+

Outcome 5 is the 'expected' level that all pupils should reach by the end of Year Two.



The results show that we are above Newport and Wales in all three areas of learning and the FPI. Both our girls and boys performed above the Welsh average.

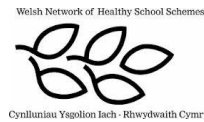
Schools are also compared to other schools in Wales with a similar level of pupils who are entitled to free school meals. Our Foundation Phase results show that we are in **top 25% of schools in Wales in Personal Social Wellbeing & Cultural Diversity, Mathematical Development and the Foundation Phase Indicator.**

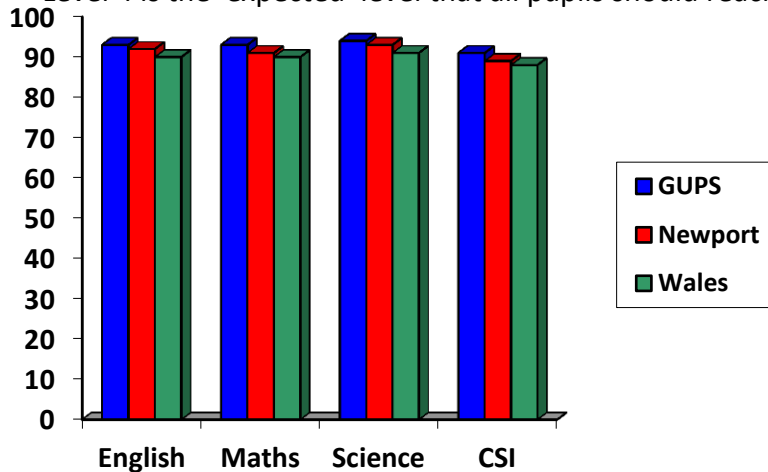

### Key Stage Two

Pupils in Year 6 are assessed according to National Curriculum levels at the end of the year in English, Maths and Science. The Core Subject Indicator (CSI) shows the number of pupils who achieved a Level 4+ in all 3 subjects. Pupils' class work and tests are used in the assessment.

### Results at Level 4+

Level 4 is the 'expected' level that all pupils should reach by the end of Year Six.



The results show that we are above Newport and Wales in all three subjects and the CSI. Both our girls and boys performed above the Welsh average. Schools are also compared to other schools in Wales with a similar level of pupils who are entitled to free school meals. Our Key Stage 2 results show that we are in **top 50% of schools in Wales in English, Maths, Science and the CSI.**
